





Standards Based Grading

- *Level 1- Student shows insufficient performance of standards "Toloro't act it wat Turced leals"
- "I don't get it yet. I need help."

 *Level 2- Student is inconsistent in showing understanding of the standards, even with teacher support "I almost get it but I need help."
- ★Level 3- Student can consistently show understanding of the standards, and may be able to show understanding in different ways.

"I get it. I can do it well."

- ★Level 4- Student can show evidence of application to other subject areas or standards. It is not just working above grade level.
 - "Since I can do/get this, I can figure out new things."








Medication
